1) Purpose

This document provides a narrow index and release note for the OSAI companion technical artifacts associated with the Phase 2 bridge layer. Its purpose is to identify the release package, preserve document-family consistency, and clarify that the Technical Concept Note should not be treated as a standalone proof layer.

This document does not define an implementation standard, governance program, certification process, runtime control model, authorization framework, or live registry operation.

2) Release Posture

The Technical Concept Note is issued with schema, resolver, and demonstration companion materials. The TCN should be read as a concept note supported by companion technical artifacts, not as the full proof layer by itself.

The companion technical artifacts remain upstream, neutral, non-operational, and model-agnostic. They define canonical reference identity structure and related lookup/separation logic without becoming authentication, authorization, enforcement, certification, or runtime governance systems.

4) Canonical Reference Identity Boundary

The release package should consistently preserve the following boundary: OSAI defines canonical reference identity records that downstream systems may cite. OSAI does not provide IAM, authentication, authorization, runtime enforcement, policy governance, certification, security controls, prompt-injection defense, an agent marketplace, or a live central registry operator.

An OSAI identity record does not certify that an agent is safe, authorized, reliable, governable, compliant, or suitable for autonomous deployment.

5) Reader Guidance

This release note should be read as an index to the May 2026 OSAI bridge artifact package. Readers should begin with the Technical Concept Note, then proceed to the companion technical artifacts in the following order: Canonical Identifier Grammar, Three-Record Schema Template Pack, Minimal Resolver Illustration, Narrow Demonstration, and Differentiation Note.

The Companion artifacts are intended to be read together. No single artifact should be treated as a complete implementation claim, standard, governance program, certification process, authorization framework, runtime-control model, or live registry operation.

6) Public Release Location and Citation

The issued bridge artifacts are maintained as public PDF assets at InfrastructureOSAI.com using document-identifier filenames. Each artifact should be cited by document identifier, title, version, and effective date.

The public documents shelf provides the preferred reading order for the issued materials. The Document Control & Revision History record remains the authoritative source for publication status, version history, and future supersession.

7) Non-Claim Statement

The release package is not a claim that OSAI is operational infrastructure, a standards body, a certification authority, a runtime control system, or a security platform. It is a controlled set of conceptual and technical companion artifacts supporting the canonical reference identity lane.
